SUNDAY MOVES to approve the first reading of Bill #13 and amend Bylaw 100 to create a new standing committee titled the *Truth and Reconciliation Implementation Committee*, based on the following first principles:

First Principles

- The Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) was a fundamental component of the Indian Residential Schools Settlement Agreement. The mandate of the TRC was to inform all Canadians of the atrocities which took place in Indian Residential Schools. Residential Schools were government-sponsored boarding schools established in the mid 19th century, with the sole purpose of the acculturation and complete assimilation of Aboriginal children. As Residential Schools were compulsory, children were forcibly taken from their parents and frequently subjected to physical, emotional, and sexual abuse. The TRC's main goal was to guide both Aboriginal Peoples and Canada-at-large along the path towards reconciliation and healing. In its final report, the TRC listed a set of *Calls for Action*, a set of principles to guide in the journey of reconciliation.
- 2. The purpose of this committee will be to foster healthy, respectful relationships with Aboriginal students on Campus. Moreover, in further implementing elements of the TRC, Students' Council creates both accountability to Aboriginal students and in carrying the spirit of reconciliation. As many Aboriginal students do not feel the Students' Union represents—or is for—them, the creation and work of this committee would be an effective first-step in assuaging these hesitations.
- 3. The Truth and Reconciliation Implementation Committee will have the following mandate:
 - a. Shall make recommendations to Students' Council on the implementation of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's Calls to Action;
 - Shall ensure adequate consultation is completed by Students' Council in regards to Aboriginal students on Campus;
 - c. Assist, after consultation, Students' Council in identifying Aboriginal priorities;

	d. Develop strategies on the respectful implementation of

	e. Foster collaboration between the Students' Council and
	Aboriginal communities;
	f. Review Students' Council Standing Committees and report on
	their progress in implementing the Truth and Reconciliation

	represented and consulted Aboriginal Students.
	g. Periodically review the Executive Committee of the Students'
	Union in relation to the Truth and Reconciliation

Hi Council,

Reading week has been quite packed with meetings, as it's just VP Ghossein and I in the office attending the work of five executives. I hope you're all enjoying your Reading week, and are exciting for elections' campaigns to take off this coming week.

Here is an update on my activities since we last met:

1. Student Groups

The Dean of Students office has given us a first draft of the revised student group policy, which tends to avoid language around student group discipline, and instead focuses on recognition agreement with the University. It also notes that there are independent processes maintained by Student Group Services (SGS). That presents a lot of possibility for SGS to address some concerns we've had with student group administration in the past.

VP Ghossein and I will continue to work with the Dean of Students office to refine the university policy, as well as update any SGS protocols in collaboration with our staff. We have had a chance to discuss this internally as well as at the Dean's Advisory Committee.

2. CAC

I attended the most recent meeting of CAC with VP Ghossein, where SU executive salaries came up as a point of discussion. They'll be further discussed at Finance committee next time they reconvene.

3. CASA

CASA's Federal Policy Committee had our last meeting before we meet in person for our AGM. We finalized our submissions to the AGM agenda, which includes revisions to some of our old policies in light of the changes to the Canada Student Loans Program.

One item we were unable to completely address this year was the fee assessment exemption for lowincome families, and its incompatibility with some of the current CASA policy. I'm working with CASA home office to leave notes for next year's team to rectify this.

4. Academic Governance

I was at a meeting of the Academic Planning Committee, which had a quite busy agenda. In particular, there were two Mandatory Instruction Support Fees that were approved that I disagreed with. One was in Education, where the proposal indicated that student consultation would occur after



the motion to approve it. The other was in Engineering, which had support from the ESS, but fees would be used to support bringing instructors from out of town. I'm sure the latter will bring value to Engineering students, regardless.

The Signature Areas Development Panel has also been hard at work trying to find a U of A-unique way to identify areas that the U of A can be distinctly known by. I don't think the panel is close to a solution, but I myself am learning a lot about the diversity and breadth of research we have here.

I proxyed for VP Banister at a meeting of GFC Replenishment Committee, where names will eventually head to GFC Exec or GFC for approval to fill vacancies on the respective bodies.

5. Myer Horowitz Renovations

I've been taking on a bit of VP Paches' work with the Myer Horowitz Renovations in small pieces. Particularly, I've been assisting Vitreo with their feasibility study. We are currently setting up interviews with key alumni to understand their receptiveness to the project.

6. CAUS

CAUS had a full teleconference meeting where we finalized some of our asks for the upcoming advocacy week in early April. We're finalizing how we may respond to the upcoming budget based on its outcomes for students. Finally, we set aside presentation topics for our Changeover with incoming CAUS members in May.

7. Internal SU Projects

VP Ghossein and I attended our monthly Core Managers meeting, where we had a very productive conversation on our information sharing agreement with the university, as well as our online presence strategy. I missed having the valuable feedback from the three VPs away on elections quite a bit here.

8. Presence and Relevancy

With Reading Week, there haven't been too many activities on campus for me to attend. I have been managing the U-Pass Yes Side Referendum, and hope you all enjoy the posters you'll be seeing around campus shortly! Message me if you want a sneak peek at some of the more humorous ones.

Reviewed Written Qs.

COUNCILLOR DEJONG TO VP SANDARE:

VP did outline reasons why policy committee is important. Will you commit to policy committee from now on? This includes having assigned work on the committee and council agenda on time and not arriving late.

VP SANDARE'S RESPONSE:

Yes, of course. Ensuring that he commits is important for the SU and himself.

GOVERNOR CHAMPAGNE TO VP SANDARE:

Where will the remaining of the 5K grant go?

VP SANDARE'S RESPONSE:

The SU paid \$1100 in addition to the 5K we got and the extra \$728. So the extra cost totalled \$1100. That is a very small fraction of what was budgeted.

COUNCILLOR MONDA TO VP SANDARE:

Please share with us your goals for policy committee.

VP SANDARE'S RESPONSE:

Supporting the SU as we go through 4 more policies that have to be done, the advocacy work is supported, work as VP external, what CAC is doing. Making sure that he's present.

COUNCILLOR PERSAD TO VP SANDARE:

Stats re EMP Fest per faculty.

VP SANDARE'S RESPONSE:

The stats concerned students as a whole and not per faculty, hopes to do this next year.

COUNCILLOR CHRISTENSEN TO VP SANDARE:

It sounds like VP has been having difficulty balancing certain aspects, have you been neglecting other aspects due to EMP Fest.

VP SANDARE'S RESPONSE:

He is not struggly with policy committee. It's doing very well.

GOVERNOR CHAMPAGNE TO VP SANDARE:

Do you expect to receive the grant funding for EMP fest every year?

VP SANDARE'S RESPONSE:

Does not know if we get grants every year but we know how much it will cost so it will be much easier. We have communicated to the business community that this is a viable project and is hopeful to get more funding in subsequent years.

COUNCILLOR LARSEN TO COUNCILLOR DEJONG:

What the process was the MNIF policy and how many meetings this took

COUNCILLOR DEJONG'S RESPONSE:

The policy went under the committee's radar in the Fall. She doesn't remember the time. We talked about it during meetings in Jan and saw the edited first principles 2 weeks ago and VP Ext provided his edits and the committee edited it in addition. It was an effort of the whole not individual.

VP SANDARE TO COUNCILLOR DEJONG:

We're in the last semester of council so we have 4 more policies set to expire in April and with 4 weeks left, why is it taking so long? **COUNCILLOR DEJONG'S RESPONSE:**

It was a shortcoming on her part. She takes responsibility for leading the community in that respect. She's confident that they'll get through everything before the term ends.

COUNCILLOR PROCHNAU TO COUNCILLOR DEJONG:

There wasn't a deadline set for MNIF policy. Why is this such a huge issue if it isn't completed/voted on before the end of term.

COUNCILLOR DEJONG'S RESPONSE:

She never assigns firm deadline. She said early in the deadline she's not going to assign deadline because she trusted the exec's ability to schedule themselves. If we didn't start seeing progress then would start assigning deadlines. She has asked the VP to start providing things by the next meeting and there has been a few times where the VP did not produce them by that meeting. She thinks her questions have been reasonable.

COUNCILLOR MONDA TO VP SANDARE:

Why has a citation not have been produced for the MNIF policy.

VP SANDARE'S RESPONSE:

Unfortunately, not. It's been very busy with EMP Fest and making sure the festival was within the budget was something he took pride in.

SUNDAY TO COUNCILLOR DEJONG:

Has the policy committee done anything to remove the gendered language in standing orders eg. on SU website?

COUNCILLOR DEJONG'S RESPONSE:

Took a look through it and did not see any gendered language. She can double check. She will fix it by next meeting.

VP SANDARE TO COUNCILLOR DEJONG:

So with some contentious policies coming up, does she have any contingency plan if it's not passed?

COUNCILLOR DEJONG'S RESPONSE:

Has not discussed this yet. If necessary, will call extra meetings.

PRESIDENT RAHMAN TO GOVERNOR CHAMPAGNE:

What would he like to clarify?

GOVERNOR CHAMPAGNE'S RESPONSE:

He heard that we had 4 weeks of council left but we have 4 meetings left. Just to keep in mind, we do have 4 meetings of council not 4 weeks.

COUNCILLOR MONDA TO VP GHOSSEIN:

Would you like to give us an update on the upcoming LHSA elections?

VP GHOSSEIN'S RESPONSE:

Last Thursday was the first general meeting. The purpose of it was to get the constitution passed. It needs to be approved in order to submit it to SGS. On the SU website, there's a timeline for LHSA elections. They elect a president, VPs and other members. She's happy that we were able to start this in Feb. That collab with Dean of Students have been doing smoothly.
