Chief Returning Officer – Candidate Introduction

Introduction:

I hope this reaches you in good health. It is an honor to be selected as the Chief Returning Officer for the University of Alberta Student's Union and I hope to perform to the best of my abilities in reaching the set goals over the next four months. I am currently a second-year international student at the University of Alberta's School of Business, majoring in Finance.

Background:

I have been involved in student governance and politics since the past few years, often dealing with campaigns at a national level, budgeting and acting as a poll agent. Having served as the Deputy Returning Officer for the Augustana Students' Association at the University of Alberta's Augustana campus during the last academic year taught me a lot in terms of university elections and governance. I oversaw two elections for the academic year 2018-19 ensuring a level playing field for all candidates. Worked closely with the Students' Union of the University of Alberta, and the Chief Returning Officer at that time making sure that all the rules and regulations were followed. During this process, I had to deal with a fair share of problems which revolved around hate speech and racism, with a fair share of drama which I feel was dealt in the best way possible. As a student leader during my high school days in Pakistan, I was responsible for managing events which were budgeted at \$250,000+. Last summer I managed the final country wide tour for the Pepsi Battle of the Bands Season 4, as well as conducted a cost benefit analysis to evaluate the impact of industry 4.0 and its integration into different industries in South East Asia, specifically Pakistan, during my internship at Tetra Pak.

Plans:

Being drafted halfway through the year in the middle of things is always difficult but nonetheless the goals for the upcoming elections are to get the numbers up. By this, I plan on engaging more students to participate in the elections process, and vote in the elections. Some of the things under consideration are having physical polling booths, an extensive digital/social media campaign and increased awareness about election in general. This year the elections office will be responsive, and all communications will be made in a professional and respectful manner in the requested time. While improving the numbers game and participation the elections office will ensure strict adherence to the by-laws making sure that the rules and regulations are followed and that hate speech, racism and discrimination is not tolerated.

Work done so far:

Since being offered the position in the second week of December and realizing the shortage of time, I had to start working for the elections before being rectified. I have met the marketing department at the Students' Union, exchanging ideas and formulating a strong social media and marketing plan. Some new ideas which have been drafted in include having "I VOTED" stickers etc... Having formulated an elections timeline which, you can see attached below, I will be meeting Jason Ward later today in order to discuss the possibility of having physical polling booths with laptops. There were some issues faced such as the Myer Horowitz being

unavailable during the election period because of which another venue had to be booked, nomination period being too short, marketing plan being weak etc... all of which were sorted out. Over the next week, I will be taking over the elections office, overseeing the hiring of the DROs, meeting with marketing and finalizing the nomination packages.

With your support I hope to lead an impartial, engaging and responsible elections office over the next four months, ensuring a visible change in polling numbers and student participation.
