

# STUDENTS' COUNCIL

The University of Alberta and the University of Alberta Students' Union occupy Indigenous land in amiskwacîswâskahikan (Beaver Hills House), on Treaty 6 territory. From time immemorial, the banks along the river valley have been known as the Pehonan, a meeting place for the nêhiyawak (Cree), the Niitsítapi (Blackfoot), Métis, Dënesųliné (Dene), Ojibway/Saulteaux/Anishinaabe, Haudenosaunee and others. The University, the Students' Union and much of the city are located on the unlawfully stolen land of the forcibly removed Papaschase Cree.

We acknowledge that sharing this land gives each of us the responsibility to research the historic contexts of Treaty 6, to reflect on our personal relationships to the land, the Nations we've named, and to our roles in upholding justice on this territory. Since they began, the Students' Union and the University have benefited from historic and ongoing dispossession of land and resources from Indigenous Peoples. As a result, it is our responsibility to seek the restitution of this land and its resources. Finally, we seek to do better by working to make our learning, research, and governance align with the histories, languages, teachings, and cultures of First Nations, Métis, and Inuit Peoples in the land presently occupied by the Canadian state.

We encourage critical reflection by asking the following question. In relation to the territory on which you are situated, what role do you play in strengthening the resistance and resurgence of Indigenous students within your communities?



# **Council Report #18**

#### Hi Council!

Below is an overview of the executive committee's recent activities.

## **Exam Rescheduling Procedure (Pedro)**

Over the past few months, the SU has been engaging with the University as it has proposed the Exam Rescheduling Procedure. This is a procedure in response to the move towards three exam slots per day starting in Fall 2024, to prevent students from having an exam schedule that is too dense (e.g. it would allow students to reschedule an exam if they had three exams in one day). Through collaboration with the RO, we have been able to significantly improve the procedure for students and I am hoping to provide the full details at the next meeting of Council, but feel free to ask any questions.

# **Health and Dental Plan (Michael)**

We are approaching that time of the year where we will soon have to renew the structure of our health and dental plan. Myself, the Health and Dental Plan Committee, and our StudentCare Program Manager are currently reviewing the financial health of our plan, as well as what areas students access most. Our work will also be informed by a recent survey of students' satisfaction with, and needs from the health and dental plan. You can expect an updated proposal for your approval at our last council meeting!

# <u>Sustainability Committee (Michael)</u>

The Sustainability Committee has just adjudicated the recent round of Green Fund applications. Projects are adjudicated based on several criteria, including their social,

environmental, and financial sustainability. This year the committee approved a <u>new rubric</u> to help facilitate adjudications according to these metrics. We elected to award 2 more projects funding, bringing the total awarded this year to more than \$20,000 that has gone to support five projects. At our final meeting, the committee will be holistically discussing the sustainability efforts of the organization over the past year.

## **Tuition Advocacy (Chris, Christian)**

On March 22nd, the Board of Governors approved the tuition proposals for the Domestic fall 2024 cohort and the international student tuition proposals for the fall 2025 cohort. In addition to these proposals, the Board also approved the 2024/25 consolidated budget. While the boards decision was disappointing, it was great to see continued solidarity from NASA, ASSUA and GFC rep to BoG Dilini Vethanayagam in standing in opposition to these proposals that would make life harder. Going forward, the Board has committed to work through and psome of the proposals submitted by the Students' Union specifically on the proposals focusing on financial aid.

## **Presidential Review Committee (Christian)**

The Presidential Review committee had its first meeting to begin the process of evaluating the performance of President Flanagan. As previously mentioned, President Bill Flanagan has advised the Chair of the Board of Governors, Kate Chisholm, that he would like to put his name forward to serve a second term as President of the University of Alberta. President Flanagan's current term is scheduled to expire on July 1, 2025. While the matters of the committee continue to remained confidential, I can update council that the process is unfolding as it should.

# **Media Interviews (Christian and Chris)**

On March 25th, Chris was interviewed by Janet French as the Chair of CAUS for a piece on student loan repayment. The interview was used for an <u>article</u> and radio. On Tuesday, March 26th, Chris was on CBC news discussing student loan debt as well. On Wednesday, March 27th Chris appeared on the Alberta at Noon radio show for an hour long conversation with the host Doug Dirks and University of Calgary Students' Union President Shaziah Jinnah-Morsette. On that day, President Fotang also had an interview with CHED radio to discuss the results and impact of the BoG vote to approve tuition increases.

# **New University of Alberta Chancellor (Pedro & Chris)**

As it has been announced to the University community, and many of you may have heard if you are part of GFC/BoG, the University of Alberta Senate has elected its 23rd Chancellor, Nizar J. Somji. We are all very excited to get to know Nizar over the coming months, as he is set to begin his five-year term in June. We would like to thank the work of the Nomination of Chancellor especially the work of VPA and former Senator, Pedro Almeida, in bringing the student perspective and voice to the process.
